While this event is specifically designed for students in Grades 2-5, everyone is welcome!

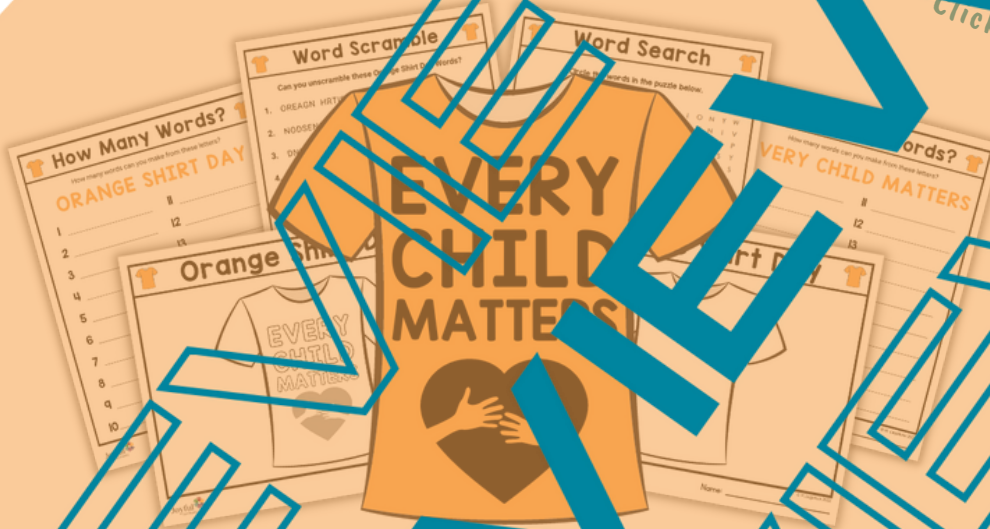
